The cohort includes first-year students, transfer students, and students in the online program who first declared Accounting or Business Administration during the selected year and subsequently enrolled in at least one course. Students who switched majors or left Chaminade without graduating count against the rate. Graduation is program-specific — a student must have completed the same program they declared to count as a graduate.
B.A. Business Administration Graduation Rate	The rates reflect the percentage of students who first declared their program during the indicated academic year and graduated within four (4) or six (6) years of their first term at Chaminade.
